WHERE?

Creation Museum

WHY?

Exploring our origins from a biblical standpoint affirms BJA's mission statement—to challenge our students to embrace God's truth—while supporting our core values of biblical integration and critical thinking. This trip correlates well with our 7th-grade life science curriculum and enhances student learning in this core academic class.

WHEN?

Wednesday through Friday, October 18 - 20, 2017
Depart at 7:30 a.m. on Wednesday and return at 11 p.m. on Friday

COST?

The cost of \$275 for the three-day trip covers transportation (BJU coach bus and an activity bus), lodging, entry fees, and six meals. Additional expenses include souvenirs and two fast-food meals while traveling.

WHAT?

Our trip will be hosted by Dan Wooster and Camp Infinity. Planned activities include the Creation Museum Planetarium, stargazing (weather permitting), riding a zip line, and games at the campground.

- Big Bone Lick State Park/Ark Encounter; lunch (included)
- Return to Greenville (one fast-food meal en route)
