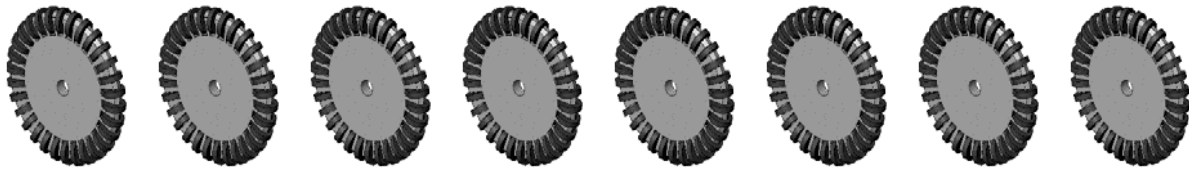

BJA MS Robotics Team Contract

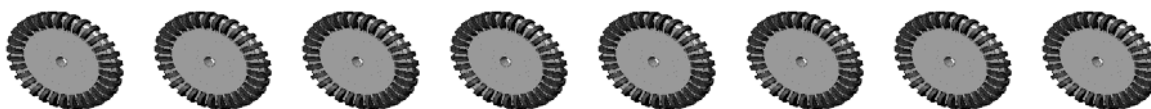
- ❖ **Club Mission: To emphasize the place of STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) in our culture for the glory and honor of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ**
- ❖ **Club Goal: To collaborate as a team to design, build, and program a robot to compete in VEX competitions**

Team Work Defined:

- Students will make changes to the robot only after all other teammates in attendance agree to the changes.
- Students must record changes made to the robot in the Engineering Notebook.
- Changes made in the Engineering Notebook must emulate the standards expected at the competition level.
- The driver of the robot during the competition will be determined by a secret ballot vote of all the members of the present team.
- The club sponsor is the tiebreaking vote if necessary.

Respect Defined:

- Team members will not insult other team members in a joking or serious manner.
- Team members will not physically touch another teammate or prohibit them from touching the robot.
- Referrals to the Appeals Committee (A/C) will be treated as a Robotics Club infraction.



First Offense: 1 week suspension from team practices

2nd offense: 2 weeks suspension from team practices

3rd offense: Removal from team/forfeiture of fees paid

Offenses begin anew every semester.
