### Photo Permission: Release of liability/informed consent

Bob Jones Academy frequently takes photographs of recognized school activities in which your child may appear. The photos are used for a variety of internal purposes, such as a playbill and other school publications (e.g., student newspaper) and for external purposes, such as promotional literature. There are occasions when your child's name may appear along with the photo. We request your permission to use your child's name and/or photo for school publications, on the school website, or for release to newspaper or television media.

The right of privacy of information for minors enables parents to control what information is collected about their child online or in print. Operators of websites and businesses that either focus on children or knowingly collect personal information from children are required to post privacy policies, obtain parental consent before collecting information from children, allow parents to determine how such information is used and provide the opportunity for parents to opt out of future information collection from their child. The right of publicity is defined as the right of every individual to control any commercial use of his or her name, image, likeness, voice, signature, photograph, gestures, distinctive appearances, mannerisms or some other aspect of identity, limited under U.S. law by the First Amendment. The right of publicity restricts BJA from using an individual's information for commercial profit.

BJA is sensitive to and respectful of your child's rights in the areas of privacy and publicity. Therefore, BJA will not release a photo of your child without a parent's/legal guardian's informed consent on file. A parent or legal guardian reserves the right at any time to revoke consent to BJA to publish information about a child. Please respond below to the following statement.
