PUBLIC NOTIFICATION

To: Workers, Building Occupants, Children's Legal Guardians, Students, Teachers, School Board Members, and Employees of Bob Jones Academy (including preschool and elementary, middle, and high schools)

As a member of one of the above groups, this is your annually mandated notice concerning activities associated with the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) final rule regarding Asbestos Containing Building Materials (ACBM) in Schools (40 CFR Part 763, Subpart E), known as the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA):

1. Initial inspection and sampling was performed by Hall-Kimbrell Environmental Management. Re-inspection was completed in April 2015 by Terracon Consultants, Inc.
2. An asbestos abatement compliance program, known as the "Management Plan", was accepted in 1989 by the State Office of School Planning and Building, documenting any ACBM that might have been located in the schools noted above.
3. Results of the initial inspection, re-inspection and the Management Plan are available for review by interested parties at the Environmental Health & Safety office on request. Included in the Inspection Report/Management Plan are diagrams of the floors of each school building indicating material sample locations, and locations for materials assumed to be ACBM.
4. A semiannual surveillance is being continued on campus in accordance with the EPA's Final Rule and the Management Plan.
5. As a result of this required semiannual surveillance, there were no noted deficiencies requiring immediate corrective actions. Documentation is included in the Management Plan as abatement is completed. The next semiannual surveillance inspection is scheduled for January, 2020.
6. The last required triennial reinspection of facilities was completed July 11, 2018. No significant deterioration of known ACBM was detected by this reinspection. The next triennial re-inspection is scheduled for 2021.
7. Further inspections, re-inspections, response actions, and post-response action activities will be implemented in accordance with management plan schedules.
