

WILLIAMSBURG TRIP

Information for parents and students

BJA Williamsburg Trip

As we anticipate our 8th grade trip to the Museum of the Bible and Colonial Williamsburg, we trust your student is as excited about this learning experience as we are! Our teachers are looking forward to interacting with students in an informal atmosphere. We also realize the responsibility we have to provide proper supervision for your student. To assist us with that responsibility, please carefully go over the following information with your student and stress the importance of abiding by the established policies.

As part of that discussion, please also help your student think through how to reflect the Lord Jesus to others—believers and unbelievers alike—while on the trip. We trust that the trip will not only be a fun learning experience but will also contribute to the spiritual and social growth of our students!

DEPARTURE/RETURN

- Departure: In front of the Applied Studies Building (where we have MS chapel) at 12:30 p.m. on Monday, December 16. Students should plan to drop off their luggage in the chapel room when they arrive that morning. Students need to be orderly and helpful as we load the bus.
- Return: At middle school building around 8 p.m. on Friday, December 20. Students will be instructed to call/text home when we are one hour away from school.

BUSTRIP

- Snacks: Dry snacks (nuts, chips) are fine; please do not bring sticky
 foods or any form of chocolate. Students may drink only water on the
 bus, and to minimize spills, beverage containers should have a screw-on
 cap. Because the bus makes few stops, students need to limit fluid intake
 while traveling.
- Bus entertainment: Books, games, game systems with approved games, and approved games on phones. Students may not access the Internet or use their phones or other devices as hot spots. Of course, all content should abide by school expectations. Because of the risk of devices being lost or damaged, we discourage students from bringing expensive electronic devices on the buses.

CELL PHONE USE

- Cell phones may be used <u>with permission from a chaperone</u>. Students will be encouraged to communicate with parents – calling or texting at convenient times each day to keep parents updated.
- Phones may be also used for playing approved games, reading acceptable books, and taking appropriate photos.
- Phones are not to be connected to Wi-Fi or to use data to connect to social media of any kind, to watch videos/movies, or to listen to music.
- Phones should be set to silent when on tours.
- Chaperones may collect all phones at various times; phones will be collected in the hotel at lights out and returned at breakfast.
- Phone privileges may be lost if guidelines are not followed.

PACKING LIST

- Students should pack lightly and bring only what is necessary. Lodging will be at SpringHill Suites by Marriott, Centreville, VA, and Courtyard by Marriott Williamsburg.
- School trip medication form (available from the office or <u>online</u>) along with any needed medications
- medium-size suitcase or bag, marked with the student's name
- Personal toiletries
- Camera, including batteries and memory card if desired; cell phones may be used as cameras
- Cell phone, if desired
- Clothing—being able to layer is important since temperatures may vary during the day; mix and match when possible; bringing a jacket or winter coat. We have had rain and cold temperatures on this trip!
- Comfortable shoes for cold weather we do a lot of walking
- Guys: properly fitting neat jeans or slacks; uniform shirts
- Girls: properly fitting neat jeans or slacks; uniform shirts
- Other (Bible; compact umbrella; money for 9 fast-food meals as well as for souvenirs and tips, including a \$4–\$6 tip for the ladies who prepare the breakfast buffet—please keep food and souvenir money separate)
- Small bag or backpack for bus
