We would like to again invite our families to participate by donating food items to be given to needy families. Due to the current health situation, the BJU Ministry Class (who we have historically partnered with) will not be distributing boxes. Instead, this year we are going to work together to provide much needed items for the Miracle Hill Food Warehouse. Each month they provide a food box to families and individuals experiencing food insecurity. We are so excited to have an outlet to continue to be a blessing to families in need during this time.

Following is a list of items for each grade level. Students may bring in their items to their classrooms during the week of November 9-13, and on November 13, all our items will be transported to Miracle Hill for distribution.

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| K3 Boxes of Mac 'n Cheese | 2 Canned fruit or fruit cups |
| K4 Boxes/bags of stuffing or instant mashed potatoes | 3 Cans of non-creamed soup (ie, chicken noodle, vegetable) |
| K5 Brownie or Cake Mixes | 4 Cans of creamed soup (ie, chicken, mushroom) |
| 1 Cans of corn | 5 Cans of green beans |
