

# Grades 6-12 Discipline Overview

Both the Middle School (6–8) and High School (9–12) use discipline points to help identify both patterns and degrees of misbehaviors and to provide a range for an objective and appropriate corrective response. Teachers and respective Support Committees use the ranges below to issue discipline points, which are recorded in Sycamore software. A student's parent will be notified by the teacher or Support Committee (Middle School: <a href="mailto:bja.mssc@bobjonesacademy.net">bja.mssc@bobjonesacademy.net</a>) anytime a discipline point is issued (tardies: discipline points and communication handled after each 5<sup>th</sup> tardy).
