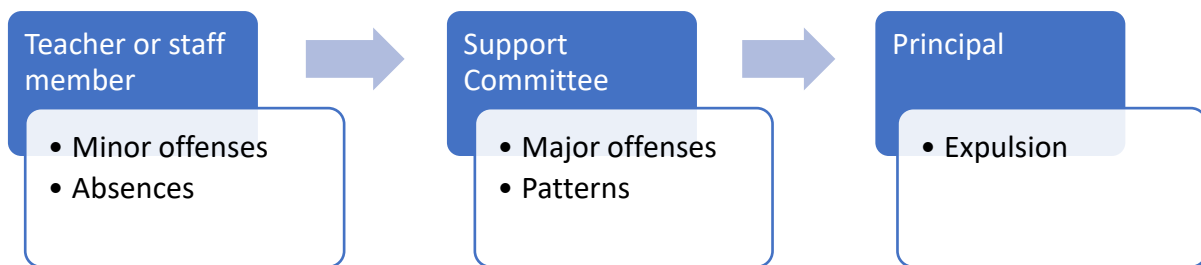


Both the Middle School (6–8) and High School (9–12) use discipline points to help identify both patterns and degrees of misbehaviors and to provide a range for an objective and appropriate corrective response. Teachers and respective Support Committees use the ranges below to issue discipline points, which are recorded in Sycamore software. A student’s parent will be notified by the teacher or Support Committee (Middle School: bja.mssc@bobjonesacademy.net; High School: bja.hssc@bobjonesacademy.net) anytime a discipline point is issued (tardies: discipline points and communication handled after each 5th tardy).

Offenses and Discipline Points

Minor (teacher issues points)

Tardy (up to 10 min late)	2 pts
Dress Code infraction	2 pts
Disruptive behavior	2-15 pts
Failure to follow instructions	2-10 pts
Misuse of technology	2-15 pts

Major (Support Committee issues points)

Bullying	50-100 pts
Cheating	10-25 pts
Controlled or age-restricted substance	50-100 pts
Fighting	10-25 pts
Moral indiscretion	50-100 pts
Profanity	10-25 pts
Stealing	10-50 pts
Unexcused absence	5-10 pts
Vandalism	10-25 pts

Action Thresholds (Discipline points accumulate through the school year.)
