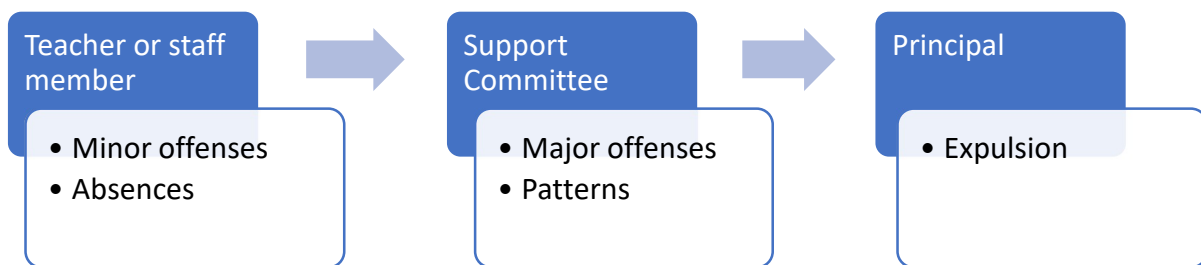


Both the Middle School (6–8) and High School (9–12) use demerits to help identify both patterns and degrees of misbehaviors and to provide a range for an objective and appropriate corrective response. Teachers and respective Support Committees use the ranges below to issue demerits which are recorded in FACTS Family Portal. A student’s parent will be notified by the teacher or Support Committee (Middle School: [bja.mssc@bobjonesacademy.net](mailto:bja.mssc@bobjonesacademy.net); High School: [bja.hssc@bobjonesacademy.net](mailto:bja.hssc@bobjonesacademy.net)) anytime a demerit is issued.

**Offenses and Demerits**

**Minor (teacher issues points)**

Tardy (up to 10 min late)	2 demerits
Dress Code infraction	2 demerits
Disruptive behavior	2-15 demerits
Failure to follow instructions	2-10 demerits
Misuse of technology	2-15 demerits

**Major (Support Committee issues points)**

Bullying	50-100 demerits
Cheating	10-25 demerits
Controlled/age-restricted substance	50-100 demerits
Fighting	10-25 demerits
Moral indiscretion	50-100 demerits
Profanity	10-25 demerits
Stealing	10-50 demerits
Absence without permission	5-10 demerits
Vandalism	10-25 demerits

**Action Thresholds (Demerits accumulate through the school year.)**
