### Preparing for the trip

- If you are working, make arrangements with your employer immediately since all seniors are expected to go on the trip.
- If you are enrolled in any classes that are not specifically senior courses, please work with your teacher regarding your absence. You will be able to attend class on Monday.
- If you are enrolled in a BJU class, Mrs. Autry will mark these as service days. If you plan to attend your dual credit class after we return on Friday around noon, please let her know.
- If you wish to leave your car parked on campus while you are gone, you may leave it in the area designated for regular Academy parking.

### What to Bring

- Bible (print), notebook and pen
- Twin-sized bedding, pillow, towels, toiletries, alarm clock, watch
- Warm clothes (for cool evenings)
- Tennis shoes / Water shoes / Sandals / Shower shoes
- Rain gear
- Plastic bag (for wet clothes on the return trip)
- Spending money (for the coffee shop, craft shop, snack shop, and the camp store)
- Insect repellent
- Flashlight

*You may bring one suitcase, sleeping bag, pillow, and backpack*

*Be sure to put your name on all your belongings, including your bedding and pillow.*

### What not to bring

- ENO/hammocks, electronics such as phones and smart watches, or guitars. If you need a phone for emergency purposes, it will be collected and kept by the camp sponsors.

### What to wear

- **Bus trip** - casual attire (loose-fitting athletic pants/jeans, t-shirt) Please no shorts.
- **Evening Services** - shirt and pants or shorts that touch the knee (non-athletic attire) ladies are welcome to wear skirts or dresses that touch the knee
- **Activities** - t-shirt and loose-fitting athletic pants, jeans, or shorts to the knee
- **Water Activities** - dark-colored t-shirt and pants or shorts to the knee
- **Rafting** - All guys and ladies should wear dark shirts and long pants or shorts to the knee. Please no tank tops.

### Leaving campus

- Luggage: Bring your sleeping bag and your suitcase to the lobby of the Academy auditorium when you arrive at school on Monday. All luggage will be transported separately on a truck. The truck will leave campus around noon.
- Meet in front of the Academy Main building immediately after school to begin loading the buses (pillows and backpacks will be carried on the bus.)
- You may change your clothes before leaving, but please remember to do so in the Academy gym locker room.
