DISCIPLINE POLICY

Our goal is for each child to develop patterns of behavior which are consistent with Scripture. Behavioral boundaries and limits are necessary for children as they learn to get along with their peers, respond well to authority, and adjust to scriptural standards.

Teachers will strive to promote acceptable behavior by modeling it themselves and by reinforcing appropriate behavior through various means of positive reinforcement and praise.

Parents will be notified via email, phone call, or note should their child display a pattern of inappropriate behavior. Consistent, unacceptable behavior will be dealt with at the discretion of the building coordinator and/or assistant principal and/or the principal and may include suspension or expulsion from the facility.

There may be a reasonable use of "time-out" or the loss of privileges. Bob Jones Academy school personnel will not administer corporal punishment nor initiate its use by parents.
