PUBLIC NOTIFICATION

To: Workers, Building Occupants, Children's Legal Guardians, Students, Teachers, School Board Members, and Employees of Bob Jones Academy (including preschool and elementary, middle, and high schools)

As a member of one of the above groups, this is your annually mandated notice concerning activities associated with the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) Final Rule regarding Asbestos Containing Building Materials (ACBM) in Schools (40 CFR Part 763, Subpart E), known as the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA).

1. Initial inspection and sampling were performed by Hall-Kimbrell Environmental Management. Reinspection was completed in April 2015 by Terracon Consultants, Inc.
2. An asbestos abatement compliance program, known as the "Management Plan" was accepted in 1989 by the State Office of School Planning and Building, documenting any ACBM that may have been located in the schools noted above.
3. Results of the initial inspection, reinspection and the Management Plan are available for review by interested parties at the Environmental Health & Safety office upon request. Included in the Inspection Report/Management Plan are diagrams of the floors of each school building indicating material sample locations, and locations of materials assumed to be ACBM.
4. Semiannual surveillance is being continued on campus in accordance with the EPA's Final Rule and the Management Plan.
5. This required semiannual surveillance found no noted deficiencies requiring immediate corrective actions. Documentation is included in the Management Plan as abatement is completed. The next semiannual surveillance is scheduled for January 2027.
6. The last required triannual reinspection of facilities was completed by Environmental Testing & Management, Inc. on December 6, 2024. No significant deterioration of known ACBM was detected during this reinspection. The next triannual reinspection is scheduled for December 2027.
7. Further inspections, reinspections, response actions, and post-response actions will be implemented in accordance with management plan schedules.
